### Pollination Notes

These varieties of **Sweet Cherries** are **self-fertile**: Black Gold, Glacier, Lapins, Stella, Sweetheart, Tehranivee, and Vandelay.

**Tart or Pie (Sour) Cherries** are **self-fertile**. These include: Evans, Montmorency, Morello, Northstar, and Surefire.

**Dwarf Bush Cherry** varieties: Carmine Jewel, Crimson Jewel, Crimson Passion, Juliet, and Romeo are sour cherries that are bred to be sweet. These varieties are **pollinators** as well as **self-fertile**.

### Directions for use of pollination chart:

1. From the left-hand column select a cultivar you are interested in growing.
2. Check across the chart; the unmarked boxes will be a reliable pollinizer for the cultivar you have chosen.
