Note:

* These are the best apple for ripening in Western Washington.

"X" These are not reliable pollinizers and must have another tree to pollintae.

Note: Zestar is a very early blooming variety. For best results use another early blooming apple variety like Braeburn, Liberty, or Lodi. Everest crabapples work well too.

The following varieties do not make good pollinizers since these are triploid plants which do not pollinate other trees. These varieties must have another tree to pollinate themselves plus the pollinizer will require another to pollinize it: GRAVENSTEIN, JONAGOLD, & KING.

Directions for use of pollination chart :

1. From the left-hand column select a cultivar you are interested in growing.
2. Check across the chart; the unmarked boxes will be a reliable pollinizer for the cultivar you have chosen.
